

**Keith Philip Allison MBChB, MD, FRCS (Eng), FIMC RCS (Ed), FRCS (Plast)  
Consultant Reconstructive and Aesthetic Plastic Surgeon**

Born in Birmingham UK, married and living in North Yorkshire with my family. I attended Sheffield University Medical School, qualifying as a doctor in 1992. Basic Surgical Training took me to Stoke-on-Trent, as the then Pilot National Trauma Centre, achieving the general surgical fellowship (FRCS Eng) in 1996. I returned to the West Midlands to continue my career in Burns and Plastic Surgery, passing the FRCS (Plast) in 2002. I have also worked as a pre-hospital (BASICS) trauma care doctor for West Midlands Ambulance Service being awarded the Queen's Jubilee Medal for services to pre-hospital care. I co-owned an Events Medical Services company running hospital and First Aid facilities at events ranging from motorsports to music festivals.

I completed a clinical research doctorate in the medical application of lasers (MD). Prior to taking up my Consultant post in the UK I gained additional training in microsurgery and oncology reconstruction in Toronto, Canada, and I was one of the first plastic surgeons in the UK to undergo a formal aesthetic / cosmetic surgery training at the McIndoe Surgical Centre, East Grinstead.

I had a wide-ranging general plastic surgery practice in the NHS based at The James Cook University Hospital. My special interests were in skin cancer, burns, trauma and cancer reconstruction (particularly breast reconstruction). Most recently I helped to set up a new microsurgical breast reconstruction service in Grand Cayman in 2023.

Commencing in 2005 I ran a successful Cosmetic Surgery practice in Teesside for 12 years, where I performed facial, nose and eyelid rejuvenation surgery, breast surgery and body contouring surgery.

I retired from my NHS Consultant post in May 2024 and now continue looking after NHS patients with skin and soft tissue lesions at Tees Valley Hospital - a Ramsay hospital.

I also provide expert witness advice and reports for the GMC, Medical Defence Organisations and legal firms and I hold the **Cardiff University Bond Solon (CUBS) Medico-legal Expert Witness Train Certificate in (2018)**.
