## Medico-Legal Experience:-

After forty years of clinical work in General Surgery and Urology I retired from clinical work in 2013 to devote more time to my interest in Medico-Legal work. I now write reports for claims arising from urological or genital problems. I do not claim medico-legal expertise for any other specialties.

In recent years my Medico-Legal work has increased such that following my retirement from clinical practice and voluntarily relinquishing my License to Practice I now write about forty reports per year. My current practice consists of about 50% reports for alleged Personal Injury and 50% for alleged Medical Negligence. About 80% of my work if for the claimant and 15% for the defendant and 5% are Single Joint Expert reports.

I have experience of Court Procedure and have attended Crown Court on three occasions as a witness in Murder Trials and once for a high-cost case of alleged Personal Injury.
