QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE

My qualifications are MBChB MRCS PGCE(Dist) FHEA FRCS(Tr&Orth). I hold a substantive Consultant appointment at the Norfolk & Norwich NHS Foundation Trust and Honorary Consultant appointment at The Ipswich Hospital as a Paediatric Trauma & Orthopaedic Surgeon. Academically, I am an Honorary Senior Lecturer for the University of East Anglia, and professionally, a trust appointed GMC Appraiser.

I am a **Cardiff University Bond Solon Certified** *Expert Witness* (Civil) and a registered Medco *Indirect Medical Expert*.

I have over ten years of experience in general Trauma & Orthopaedic Surgery, treating both adults & children. I was entered onto the GMC Specialist Register for *Trauma & Orthopaedics* in 2015. I am an Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) Provider.

Since Consultant appointment in 2015, my practice has become increasingly sub-specialized primarily in **Paediatric Orthopaedics (95%)**, and **adult disability (5%)**.

I undertake a one in four Paediatric Orthopaedic oncall, and as such, I am no longer part of the adult oncall service, but continue to maintain an active interest through trauma meetings, clinical governance and clinical cover as needed, such as during the pandemic.

The Norwich Paediatric Orthopaedic Unit is a tertiary referral center, serving a further four peripheral hospitals across East Anglia, covering all aspects of Paediatric Orthopaedics, musculoskeletal infection & paediatric trauma, with dedicated virtual and face-to-face paediatric trauma clinics.

I continue to see adults, namely transitional age patients largely with foot & ankle disorders, and continue to offer an adult service for those with complex disabilities, mostly neuromuscular.

Experience

I was appointed to the position of *Trauma & Orthopaedic Registrar* on the Southwest Peninsula rotation in 2007 following successful completion of basic surgical training. My general orthopaedic training was undertaken at The Royal Cornwall Hospital, Derriford part-MOD Major Trauma Centre Plymouth and the internationally renowned Princess Elizabeth Orthopaedic Centre Exeter.

In 2012 I successfully passed the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh Intercollegiate Fellowship examination in Trauma & Orthopaedics (FRCS Tr&Orth) at the age of 31.

As a senior trainee, I developed a specialist interest in adult Foot & Ankle surgery, Paediatric Orthopaedics & Trauma.

I subsequently undertook further sub-specialist fellowship training in Paediatric Orthopaedics at two internationally recognized centers of excellence; Starship Children's Hospital Auckland New Zealand and The Children's Hospital at Westmead, Sydney Australia; in addition to further specialist training in adult Foot & Ankle surgery at the Royal Cornwall Hospital.

In recognition, I was awarded the Zimmer Travelling Trauma Fellowship Grant in 2013 by the British Orthopaedic Association and 2013 Ethicon Travelling Fellowship Grant by the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh.

Academically I have published research extensively on all aspects of adult & paediatric Trauma & Orthopaedics, and presented at scientific meetings both nationally & internationally. In 2013 I was co-recipient of the Orthopaedic Research UK prize, and have previously been awarded the Ling-Lee prize, Southwest Orthopaedic Club prize, British Orthopaedic Specialists Association prize for best Podium presentation & best Poster presentation, in recognition of original research. I have a strong commitment to teaching and medical education, obtaining a Postgraduate Certificate in Clinical Education from the Peninsula Medical School in 2013, passed with Distinction.

My Consultant practice comprises three main areas of expertise;

 the treatment of children, adolescents & teenagers with wide range of traumatic and non-traumatic disorders of the lower limb, upper limb and selected spinal disorders including neck/back pain (I do not perform spinal operating),

- the treatment of disabled children and adults, with neuromuscular disorders & complex disabilities, including cerebral palsy,

- paediatric & adult (teenage and transitional age) patients with foot & ankle disorders.

I commenced medico-legal practise in 2015. Between 2015 to 2020, I undertook reporting in both adults and children, with witness activity split approximately: 60% claimant, 30% defendant, 10% single joint expert. I produced approximately 150-175 reports per year.

I am one of the few Consultant Paediatric Orthopaedic Surgeons in the country that undertakes regular medico-legal reporting (see 'www.newa.expert' and search for "paediatric orthopaedics").

My medico-legal practise compromises the following areas;

general medico-legal reporting for soft tissue personal injury claims as defined in 1.1(16A) of the Pre-Action Protocol (MedCo accredited & registered), in children & teenage patients 18 years and below at the time of injury.

- Expert & specialist medico-legal reporting in Paediatric Orthopaedic cases, for complex bony injuries, personal injury.

- Clinical negligence reporting in Paediatric Orthopaedics.

I have acted as Expert Witness in a variety of high value Paediatric Orthopaedic cases.

I am experienced in case conferences, joint statements and have attended Court twice.
