Since my appointment at LTHT I have focused on a delivering a high quality Upper GI cancer service for the West Yorkshire region and this has helped develop my Bariatric and complex benign practice attracting tertiary referrals from across the region.

1. I have been Lead Clinician for the Upper Gastrointestinal (UGI) MDT in Leeds since September 2011. I also Chair the MDT on occasions. We have one of the largest Upper GI MDTs in the country and last year discussed well over 500 patients.
2. I provide a high quality surgical oncology service with excellent outcomes. Since January 2012, I have performed more than 120 oesophageal and gastric cancer resections with zero 30 and 90 day mortality(to date); this compares favourably with the national average of 5% 90 day mortality. 3. I have co-convened three Laparoscopic skills courses in Leeds - these courses attract Core Surgical trainees from around the country.
