I have been working as a Consultant Cardiothoracic Surgeon at the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh since May 2002.

My role includes providing a comprehensive adult cardiac and thoracic surgical service, taking part in audit, and supervision and training of junior doctors.

Surgical Experience and Results

Results of all Cardiac and Thoracic Surgical procedures performed since appointed as Consultant in 1999.

(Results updated March 2017)

I have worked in the capacity of Consultant in Cardiothoracic Surgery in the NHS for 18 years. During this time, I have performed a wide variety of cardiac and thoracic surgical procedures, including CABG, Re-Do CABG, Aortic, and Mitral Repair and Replacement Surgery with or without concomitant CABG, Double Valve Surgery, Surgery for Aortic Dissection, and Aortic Aneurysms, Post-MI VSD Repair, ASD Closure, Transection of Aorta Repair, and Surgical TAVI.

Our unit submits surgeon-specific data to the CCAD, and the SCTS. My results have always been within the range of expected mortality.

My main areas of interests are Off-Pump CABG, Total Arterial Revascularisation, Minimally Invasive Coronary Artery Surgery, Minimally Invasive Aortic Valve Surgery, TAVI, Minimally Invasive Thoracic Surgery, and Lung Cancer Surgery.

I have participated in off-pump CABG and Minimally Invasive Surgery workshops, and have demonstrated these procedures for a surgical audience (Cardiff 2001; Bhopal 2007) I have also demonstrated off-pump and minimally invasive surgery to visiting consultant surgeons from other UK units. I continue to train and mentor surgeons from my unit as well as from other units.

Research

The following are some of the research projects I have been involved with:

- 1) CORONARY: CABG Off or On Pump Revascularization Study. Principal Investigator. This is an international multicentre trial comparing off-pump versus on-pump coronary artery surgery. The primary endpoint is survival at 5 years. Funded by NIH and MRC. Recruitment completed. Follow-up Ongoing. (Initial Results published in NEJM)
- 2) Arterial Revascularisation Trial (ART): Principal Investigator. This is a BHF/MRC funded international, multicentre, randomised trial comparing bilateral versus single internal mammary artery grafting in coronary revascularisation. The primary endpoint is survival at 10 years. I have recruited (and operated on) 213 patients for this trial. Details of the trial and recruitment are available at www.cteu.org/projects/ART/main.htm.
- 3) Neurocognitive impairment after CABG: Randomised controlled trial: (Principal Investigator) Assessment of serum cerebral injury markers (S100b and NSE) and neurocognitive impairment in patients undergoing CABG for multi-vessel disease: comparison of off-pump and on-pump techniques.
 Funding obtained from Welsh Office for Research and Development.
 We randomized 60 patients with 3 vessel disease to off-pump or on-pump CABG surgery.
 Neurocognitive assessment was performed preoperatively, and at 1 week and 6 weeks after surgery. S-100b and NSE were also measured at various time frames in the perioperative period.
 We found significantly less neurocognitive impairment after off-pump CABG. The levels of serum cerebral injury markers were also lower in the off-pump CABG group. This study was published in the BMJ in November 2002.
- 4) TITRE2: Randomised trial comparing two transfusion threshold in post-CABG patients. Principal investigator.
- 5) EMPIRE This was a single-centre, randomized Phase III trial comparing Elafin vs placebo. Recruitment (target 80 patients) completed in Sept 2013. Published in Heart (2015). Coinvestigator.

- **6) EVARREST Trial: Principal Investigator**, European Coordinator. This was an Industry-sponsored Randomised Comparative Phase III Study evaluating the safety and effectiveness of EVARREST Fibrin sealant patch as an adjunct to hemostasis during cardiovascular surgery.
- 7) Mini-Mitral Trial: Principal Investigator. This is a randomized trial comparing two surgical approaches (conventional sternotomy versus mini-thoracotomy) for mitral valve repair. Funded by NIHR.
- 8) VIOLET Trial: Principal Investigator This is a randomized trial compating thoracotomy versus VATS approach for lobectomy for lung cancer.
