Current Practice:

I have been full time Vascular Consultant at London North West London University Hospital, from my appointment in 1996 until September 2020. In this role, I participated in the on call rota and undertook the Consultant of the week, managing acute admissions and vascular emergencies. In September, 2020 opted to go part time. I no longer undertake any on call activity but continue to do clinics and lists. The National Vascular Registry is the compulsory record of Vascular activity. All my major Vascular cases are recorded.

I have been the Lead Trainer in Vascular Surgery for the Trust and the Assigned Educational Supervisor. I continue to participate actively in the training of our junior doctors both within the trust and Nationally through the Aspire programme and educational activities – currently predominantly on line.

Until September 2020, I was the Associate Medical Director Responsible for Appraisal and Revalidation for LNWUH NHS Trust – in this role I was responsible for 3 hospitals and 850 doctors.

Private Practice:

I currently do 2 clinics and one day case list per week. I cover all aspects of arterial and venous disease. My clinics are in BMI hospitals. These do not have full access to interventional radiology and a hybrid suite, so patients requiring access to these facilities are admitted under my care to the private unit at Northwick Park.
