DELIVERING A HIGH QUALITY SERVICE

As a surgeon with a special interest in skull base and skin cancer, attend 2 MDT's and have been research lead for the Head & Neck MDT. I have been able to integrate skin cancer patients from Heart of England NHS Trust into a dedicated rapid—access operating list.

Our head and neck service is one of the largest in the country and our results are within the top 10% nationally as benchmarked by a national head and neck audit (DAHNO). I have a low readmission and mortality rate for my patients. Good use of NHS resources has been demonstrated by the head and neck surgeons cross-covering operating lists to reduce cancellations of patients and allow optimum use of three session operating lists. I have been involved in the production of patient information leaflets via the cancer network. Amongst my peers I have one of the highest rates of outpatient activity and lowest times from decision to treat to treat. Patient satisfaction surveys at Solihull have shown high patient satisfaction scores for the service provided. I have developed rapid access slots for head and neck and skin cancer.

I have improved service delivery by producing GP/GDP referral guidelines
I have quality assured services by introducing regular sub-specialty morbidity and mortality educational feedback

DEVELOPING A HIGH QUALITY SERVICE

Since 2006 I have personally developed a regional head and neck photodynamic therapy novel therapy service for patients with advanced head and neck cancer and have advised a DOH working group on photodynamic therapy services for England.

I have established restorative dentist MDT sessions for the rehabilitation of oral cancer patients since 2009 and established a similar service for cardiac patients. I have instituted an oral precancer clinic utilising novel proteomic techniques to define those patients at risk of oral cancer since 2010. Along with the PCT and local dental committee I developed clinical guidelines for referrals to secondary care from primary care. This has reduced inappropriate referrals by 15%. Along with Solihull Care Trust I have developed out of hours referral guidelines for a local NHS direct service for dental emergencies. I am the consultant lead in a managed clinical network for oral surgery across the Birmingham and Solihull commissioning cluster. Cross covering colleagues and the use of three session operating lists has reduced cancer waits for head and neck cancer.

I have developed a dedicated three session rapid access operating list for skin cancer patients referred to me. I have helped develop and establish a centralised oral and maxillofacial service for Birmingham and have published widely. I have been working to develop a departmental sedation service
