## EXPERIENCE

### Summary

I have been a Consultant in General Surgery with a Special Interest in Breast Cancer since 1994. I served on the Emergency General Surgery rota until 2014 when I took 24-hour retirement from the NHS, returning to full time practice thereafter. I currently work 10 sessions in the NHS undertaking elective work and I also undertake private practice based at Spire Gatwick Park Hospital where I chair the Medical Advisory Committee.

I was Macmillan Lead Clinician for Cancer at Surrey & Sussex Trust for 15 years. I have also been involved in training courses at the Royal College of Surgeons since 1999 and am currently an examiner for Final MB at Brighton & Sussex University. I obtained a Master of Laws degree in 2010 and have undertaken regular medico-legal work since 2010.

I was awarded a National Bronze Clinical Excellence Award in 2008.

### Breast Surgery

#### *Breast Service*

On appointment I introduced a comprehensive surgical breast service into the trust including 1-stop diagnostic clinics, joint oncology clinics and breast pain clinics. I also developed a weekly multidisciplinary team meeting to plan treatment. These meetings had not existed before.

I subsequently introduced a range of new surgical procedures including immediate total breast reconstruction using pedicled flaps (including TRAM flaps), and implants with acellular dermal matrix, and oncoplastic conservative breast surgery including therapeutic mammoplasty. Later I introduced sentinel node biopsy using radioactive tracer which involved training a team of specialists in the technique.

*Breast Lead*

I am currently Lead Breast Clinician which involves leading a multidisciplinary team of 18 specialist doctors and nurses, job planning and introducing breast clinics 5 days a week, as well as preparing annual reports for Peer Review, and for CQC visits. Our multidisciplinary team treats around 350 new breast cancer patients a year with referral increasing year on year.

*Independent Sector*

I provide a breast service in the independent sector that mirrors my NHS practice.

*Royal College of Surgeons*

I was Director of the Specialty Skills Course in Breast Surgery at a Royal College of Surgeons of England until 2015 and remain on the faculty participating in courses there twice a year. I was Breast Tutor at the College for a year, while I re-edited one of the course manuals, and a member of the Oncoplastic Breast Surgery Faculty. I visited the USA and Germany to develop surgical skills and was co-author of training manual on breast surgery.

**Thyroid & Parathyroid Surgery**

I have undertaken thyroid and parathyroid surgery since the early 1980s, introducing targetted parathyroidectomy into the trust. I ceased this work in 2016.

**Minimally Invasive (Laparoscopic) & Hernia Surgery**

I have undertaken laparoscopic surgery since the early 1990s. I was the first surgeon to introduce laparoscopic appendicectomy and laparoscopic inguinal hernia repair into the trust, and subsequently published results on laparoscopic appendicectomy. I continue to perform laparoscopic inguinal hernia repair using the approved extraperitoneal (TEPS) technique.

**General Surgery**

I served on the Emergency General Surgical rota throughout my career until 2014. Until then I undertook surgery for appendicitis (including

laparoscopic appendicectomy), bowel obstruction, peritonitis, gastrointestinal bleeding and abdominal trauma on a regular basis.

## **Other relevant experience**

### **Education**

I am an educational supervisor in my trust and hold Deanery certificates in Training and Educational Supervision. I was also a member of the Training the Trainers Faculty and the Training and Assessment in Practice Faculty at the Royal College of Surgeons of England as well as the Breast Faculty and the newly introduced Law Faculty. I visited Romania with the college in 2005 as part of a training team.

I currently serve as an examiner at Brighton & Sussex University Medical School.

### **Clinical Governance**

#### *NHS*

As Lead Clinician for Cancer until 2014 I had to introduce new working practices into the trust, overseeing introduction of the National Cancer Plan and rolling out multidisciplinary team working across the trust. I was also involved in preparing for Peer Review and trying and ensuring government targets are met. I sat on the Cancer Policy Board for the Surrey, West Sussex & Hampshire Cancer Network to ensure equitable cancer services across Surrey and West Sussex. I have also also peer reviewed other Trusts and was briefly an adviser to the Appointments Committee at the Royal College of Surgeons.

More recently I had to investigate poor practice as a part of disciplinary proceedings and to undertake training in Root Cause Analysis. I also completed a Master of Laws Degree Course at Cardiff University in Legal Aspects of Medical Practice in 2009 which I passed with Distinction.

I have been trained as an appraiser for revalidation.

#### *Independent Sector*

From 1999 until 2016, I was Chairman of the Medical Advisory Committee of

Spire Gatwick Park Hospital, where I practice privately. In that role I have had to introduce new governance procedures, attend CQC visits and undertake professional conduct reviews on a number of occasions.

## Research & Audit

I have supported a number of clinical trials and audits involving the treatment of breast cancer and hold the Certificate in Good Clinical Practice (International Conference on Harmonization). I have assisted in reviewing NCEPOD returns in the past. I have published 31 papers, 6 book chapters, a book (as co-author) and a manual for the Royal College of Surgeons.

## Medico-legal Work

I am a member of the Expert Witness Institute and hold a Master of Laws degree from Cardiff University Law School. I have completed courses in Medico-legal Report Writing, Court Appearance and Mediation and have prepared reports for Claimants and Defendants, the NHS Litigation Authority and the General Medical Council. I have written over 30 medico-legal reports.

I am a member of the Legal Aspects of Surgical Practice Faculty at the Royal College of Surgeons of England and participate in courses there twice a year. I have an interest in bioethics and attended the Advanced Decision Making Workshop at Warwick University recently.

## Private Practice

I am Director of A B S BALL LTD through which I provide general surgery, medico-legal and educational services.
