I have a long track record of distinguished individual and teamwork, based on self-motivation and full respect for all levels of colleagues, with the aim of achieving quality care for all in our care. This is supported by 360 feedbacks over the years.

Within five months of starting my fixed-term appointment in Jersey, I was appointed Clinical Lead (Departmental Head) with a remit to push through a wide range of re-organisation and improvement in the hospital maternity services. This is a huge recognition of my leadership qualities and professional attributes.

I am certified for Advanced Obstetric Ultrasound and have a Special Interest in Fetal Medicine. I have over 20 years of secondary care experience, covering the full range of fetal conditions, multiple pregnancies, amniocentesis and Non-Invasive Prenatal Testing (NIPT). My publications include contribution to a reference book on obstetric ultrasound (see publications section)

Gynaecology procedures I undertake include: Hysteroscopy, endometrial ablation and other minor procedures; Diagnostic laparoscopy, Intermediate operative laparoscopy, Abdominal hysterectomy, Vaginal hysterectomy, Pelvic floor repair, Laparotomy for benign pelvic conditions, Myomectomy

Obstetric procedures I undertake include: Cervical cerclage, Fetal blood sampling, instrumental deliveries, including Kielland's rotational forceps, complex Caesarean Sections, including for morbidly adherent placenta, uterine tamponade procedures, B-Lynch suture, Caesarean hysterectomy.

Key clinical procedures devices I introduced into practice in York include: Actim Partus, Actim PROM, Propess, Fetal Fibronectin, Episcissors 60, Cook Cervical Dilator balloons. All of these were preceded by business case / application for introducing new procedure / equipment and followed by audit of effectiveness after established use.
