### **Clinical Experience**

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I continue to be in full-time practice in limb reconstruction surgery and acute trauma, including major trauma from 2002.

I regularly treat multiply injured patients, complex fractures, open fractures, and use *external fixation* such as Ilizarov and Taylor Spatial Frames.

I carry out *limb lengthening, deformity correction*, and regularly treat *osteomyelitis*. I treat complications of fractures such as *nonunion, malunion, osteomyelitis, and joint stiffness*.

I have a specialist practice in reconstruction of *foot and ankle problems after neurological injury*, after complications of diabetes, and in the treatment of *complications after amputation surgery*.

I was previously an examiner and then an examiner assessor for the Intercollegiate International Orthopaedic Examinations, Training Programme Director, member of the Specialist Advisory Council, and part of Council of the British Limb Reconstruction Society.
