Mark leads the Civil Forensic Accounting team at Sedulo. He is regularly instructed as an expert witness or advisor in relation to a variety of matters, including commercial disputes, investigations, personal injury, matrimonial disputes and business valuations.

Mark is a Member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales and has over twelve years' experience in audit and forensic accounting. He has been involved in a large number of high-value disputes in international arbitrations and the UK High Court, as well as a selection of high profile investigations. Mark started his career in accountancy working in external audit, before moving into forensic accounting and investigations. Mark's forensic career started at Mazars, a Top 10 firm, before joining the high-end boutique firm Haberman llett in 2019 as a Senior Manager. Haberman llett was later merged into Kroll (a worldwide advisory firm, previously known as Duff and Phelps).

In the above roles Mark worked on a large number of disputes and investigations under instructions from a variety of clients, including a diverse range of law firms (from magic circle to regional firms), Insolvency Practitioners, UK regulators, the US Department of Justice and major international corporates.

Prior to his forensic experience, Mark has previously been involved in (and led) statutory audit engagements on site for a variety of clients within the manufacturing, hospitality, retail and leisure sectors.  fraud and financial reporting fraud, reported as the largest fraud of this kind in UK history.
 This included leading a significant funds flow exercise and a full investigation of the
 accounting records for evidence of fraudulent accounting.
- Instructed in relation to various claims of employee fraud against a former finance director and other former employees.
- Advisory work in respect of professional negligence in relation to the statutory auditor of a high profile failed investment scheme.
- Investigation into alleged accounting fraud in respect of a post-acquisition dispute in South America.
