Professional Profile

Consultant in Gynaecology and Reproductive Medicine & Surgery at St Mary's Hospital, one of the largest gynaecology units in the UK. I hold the title of Honorary Senior Lecturer at The University of Manchester in recognition of my research contribution. My clinical practice encompasses specialist infertility and benign gynaecology clinics, outpatient hysteroscopy, and regular theatre lists with a focus on minimal access gynaecology and reproductive surgery. I participate in the on-call rota managing gynaecological emergencies and early pregnancy complications. I am proficient in ultrasound scanning and subspecialised in assisted reproduction, routinely performing oocyte retrievals and embryo transfers.

I have led change across several aspects of gynaecology, including the implementation of remote consultations during the COVID-19 pandemic, development of Trust policies and pathways, and service redesign across multiple sites. I have published in peer-reviewed journals, maintain a strong commitment to teaching, and led the development of the national British Fertility Society guideline on prevention of ovarian hyperstimulation syndrome (OHSS). I am an accredited BFS Trainer, completed the NAC Leadership Course (2018), received a Clinical **Excellence** Award (2024), and was recently elected to the **British Fertility Society Executive Committee**.

Leadership, Management of Change & Service Development

1. **DRM Website and Patient Information (Dec 2023):** Led comprehensive update of the Department of Reproductive Medicine website, including accurate success rates and a large suite of patient information leaflets (PILs), aligned with the HFEA website audit tool. Coordinated a multidisciplinary team (embryologists, andrologists, nurses, counsellors) to review and validate content.
2. **Hysterosalpingogram (HSG) Pathway Harmonisation (Nov 2022):** Led administrators and radiographers to establish a single referral pathway and centralised booking across Trafford, North Manchester, and MRI sites, **eliminating the waiting list.**
3. **Benign Gynaecology MDT (Mar 2021–Feb 2023):** Established and chaired a monthly MDT with histopathology and radiology to discuss complex benign gynaecology cases (e.g., complex fibroids, non-malignant endometrial abnormalities, complex surgical/medical co-morbidities).
4. **Virtual Consultations & Remote Working SOP (Jun 2020):** Authored the Trust policy and led implementation of virtual clinics during COVID-19 across gynaecology; conducted the largest electronic patient survey at the time demonstrating safety, feasibility and high satisfaction; published results in a peer-reviewed journal.
5. **Infertility Service Development at Wythenshawe Hospital:** Built a modern infertility service as part of MFT harmonisation: introduced AMH/AFC diagnostics and a HyCoSy clinic; established ovulation induction pathways; streamlined referrals to licensed treatments; ensured regular representation in the Reproductive Medicine MDT; created a dedicated fertility clinic; developed training opportunities leading to the appointment of an Infertility ATSM trainee.
