#### CLINICAL PRACTICE AND EXPERIENCE

I am a Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist at Dorset County Hospital NHS Foundation Trust, a position I have held since 2011, and I have been practising obstetrics and gynaecology for over 25 years since qualification.

At Dorset County Hospital I am the lead clinician for Minimal Access Gynaecological (keyhole) Surgery. Whilst there, I have introduced new surgical procedures including Total Laparoscopic Hysterectomy and Laparoscopic Resection of Endometriosis. I routinely perform general gynaecological surgical procedures including abdominal and vaginal surgery. I also manage complex pregnancy, postnatal problems and childbirth including caesarean sections and instrumental deliveries.

I teach at the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists including training doctors in laparoscopic/ hysteroscopic skills and emergency obstetrics including instrumental deliveries and shoulder dystocia. I have presented scientific research papers at both national and international meetings, and have published articles in scientific journals in the field of minimal access surgery.
