AUDIT PROJECTS

1- Criteria for the successful outcome of Gamma Nail fixation for fracture NOF.

This was performed at St Mary's Hospital, London, May 2014. We compared our results of using Gamma Nail against the standard criteria published in peer reviewed journal by Reading Hospital. Results suggested that 75% of the nails were fulfilling the criteria. **I was the main author.**

2- Antibiotic prophylaxis in the management of septic arthritis in children.

This was performed at Bristol Children Hospital, Bristol, Dec 2013.

Review of the results revealed that Paeds Orthopaedic department was not following the

trust guidelines. Therefore guidelines were revisited after discussion with the microbiology department and audit loop was completed with 100% compliance rate regarding the use of prophylactic antibiotics. **I was the main author.**

3-Review of outcome of Single Stage Revisions for infected knee Replacement

Review of 56 patients underwent Single stage revision following infected TKR and comparison with the national data. This was presented at BASK, Leeds 2013.

I was the main author.

4- Use of Intra Medullary Hip Screw (IMHS) for the treatment of Unstable Extra capsular and Femoral Shaft Fractures

This was performed at Pinderfield Hospital, MidYorkshire Trust, Wakefield in 2004-2005. IMHS was recently introduced in the department. We compared the results of this implant with other intra medullary devices. The initial result revealed less complication rate but a learning curve was noted among the junior staff. **I was main author.**

3- Suture material for wound closure of carpal tunnel Decompression.

This was performed at York Hospital in 2003-2004. Ethilon and Monocryl were used routinely in the hand unit. By reviewing the case notes there was no difference in the outcome between the two groups but Monocryl was much more expensive than Ethilon. Therefore Ethilon was used for all CTD closure, **having closed the audit loop**, there was overall saving in the cost of suture material without compromising the outcome. **I was the main author. It was presented in the American Academy of Orthopaedic surgeons (AAOS) in 2009.**

4- Audit for delay in transfer of patients with NOF fractures from the A & E to the theatre.

This was performed at St. James's University Hospital, Leeds in 2001-2002. Following this I designed a pro-forma now in common use within the accident and emergency department, **having closed the audit loop**, there was overall improvement in patient care. **I was the main author.**
