Fees, Terms and Agreement.

Medical legal referrals for scanning are usually judged by how much reading and preparation is required, in *excess* of routine referral letter:

1. Rate for preparing a report including reading medical reports, Hospital case notes, GP notes, MRI and CT scan is **£350 per hour** - this is extra to the cost of any new additional imaging report which depends on length, research etc. **Premium rate** of **£500 per hour** for 2 working days turnaround can be request on individual case basis.
2. Reference material: We have a vast access to view national material via Peer Review Journals; if we need any special items we will charge the copy-write fee. If any material needs copying, a fee will be charged.
3. I aim to provide a report in 2 weeks of the date all material including access to images made available. Date of imaging on site varies depending on site and availability following receipt of material and instruction from you.
4. The report fee will be provided pre-acceptance. Separate arrangements can be made for deferred payments on case-by-case basis.
5. Invoice will be issued and should be paid within 60 days.

Legal conferences / court appearances are itemized separately and are charged as follows:

1. Legal conference: £800/h plus travelling expenses
2. Court appearance: All need to add any travelling expenses
 - Preston: £2500 per day
 - Manchester: £3000 per day
 - London: £4200 per day
 - Abroad: £6000 per day
3. Expert Report: Standard (2 working weeks) - £350.00 per hour
Premium (2 working days) - £500.00 per hour
