I have been nominated by my peers as a Fellow of the Royal College of General Practitioners. I am a senior GP of good standing since 2010, and competent in offering advice for medical negligence and medical expert witness cases, providing reports and examinations, of the level as a forensic medical examiner, including carrying out sexual assault and rape cases. I have attended trials to give evidence as an expert witness and carried out relevant court appearance training.

Teaching

I have lectured nationally and internationally about post graduate learning in general practice. I remain active in training, education and national standard setting. I hold an honorary lecturer status from the University of Kent. I lecture nationally and present a lecture series on GMC, NHS England Medical Appraisal, CQC Inspections, Complaints and the GMC, and NHS England, and Medicolegal Expert working.

Examining

I was a GMC examiner, and now continue to aid in maintaining medical standards by being an exam writer for the National Recruitment Office, representing general practice for Kent, Surrey and Sussex.

TRAINING QUALIFICATIONS AND ACCREDITATION AS AN EXPERT WITNESS

I have been involved in medico-legal and forensic work since 2009; I have attended courses on report writing and cross-examination. I regularly participate in medico-legal CPD.

I was trained NHS England as a clinical advisor, and regularly work as a consultant for the PHSO in England, Ireland and Scotland, writing reports and offering my expert opinion in general practice management. I also work as a consultant specialist general practice advisor for the CQC, carrying out GP inspections.

I am aware of the requirements of Part 35 and Practice Direction 35, the Protocol for the Instruction of Experts to give evidence in Civil Claims and the Practice Direction on Pre-Action Conduct.

I have provided expert written and oral evidence in many different cases including civil (personal injury and clinical negligence) and criminal matters in the UK. I have given evidence in fitness to practice cases at the GMC. I have attended Court as an expert witness in England on more than 10 occasions. I now provide about 10 reports per year of which 20% are asylum related, 50% are personal injury and 25% clinical negligence. I receive instructions on behalf of both Claimants and Defendants; I am instructed as a single joint expert in less than 1% cases.
