**Potential Breach of Duty and Causation:** Did the actions of the Mammographer during the mammogram cause damage to the cardiac loop recorder?

**Procedure and standard of care provided by the Radiographer** during an MRI scan of the claimant's right knee. Did the actions, or lack thereof, cause the burns?

**Potential Breach of Duty by the Radiographer** Possible obligation of the Radiographer to have alerted the Radiologist once the MRI scan was completed.; did the delay in reporting contribute to the claimant's life changing injury.
