### **SIGNIFICANT PAST RESEARCH**

1994 Served on COIN; a national committee formulating guidelines based on evidence-based medicine for management of prostate cancer convened by the College of Radiologists. This committee has produced national guidelines for management of prostate cancer.  
1990 Elected to the steering committee of the ICI Multi-Centre study of Zoladex versus Cyproterone Acetate versus Di-ethyl-stilboestrol in the treatment of advanced prostate cancer culminating in the key note presentation of results at BAUS in 1990. This remains the biggest tolerability study of goserelin (Zoladex) in prostate cancer in the world literature.

### **IMPORTANT ORIGINAL OBSERVATIONS**

The implications of abdomino-perineal resection in terms of parasympathetic function of the bladder was an original early observation and this publication was reproduced twice and is still quoted as a standard reference in Campbell's Urology, the acknowledged standard urological reference textbook.

Responsible for the statistical analysis of the Vitamin C data in various cancers and was able to guide the researchers (Linus Pauling and Ewan Cameron) in analysis of their data.

Found the association between peri-operative blood transfusion and decreased survival in prostate and renal cancer.
