I published the first national analysis of urological litigation in the UK (Osman NI, Collins GN. Urological litigation in the UK National Health Service (NHS): an analysis of 14 years of successful claims. *BJU Int* 2011; 108: 162-5). This has become the most widely cited work on the topic.
