# Professional History

Initially on the graduate training programme, gaining experience in all aspects of a major highway authority, culminating in 18 months as Deputy Resident Engineer on the M275 Rudmore Flyover Scheme, Portsmouth which included an extension of the motorway to Portsmouth and a major 3-span composite construction flyover. I also spent an extended period in the Area Surveyors Office with responsibility for the day-to-day management of the highway network.

Following permanent appointment to the Bridge Design Office, I carried out the design of a range of highway structures in both concrete and steel. I also carried out a large number of bridge inspections on a wide variety of structures ranging from small arch structures to multi span prestressed concrete structures. During this period, I was responsible for the repair of the Council's concrete bridge structures.

I was initially appointed as an Associate and finished my career as Senior Partner.

In addition to managing the Practice, I was involved in the day to day design of a variety of structures from small domestic extensions to multi-million pound leisure facilities.

I have advised a number of loss adjusters and insurance companies on a variety of structural problems ranging from domestic subsidence and impact damage to major fires and the structural collapse of buildings and retaining walls.

Through the above I gained a great insight into the structural form of a wide variety of buildings, having inspected all types of buildings following major fires, impact damage and other structural failures.
