Profile

Hazel is an experienced and highly trained Registered General Nurse with over 20 years of NHS experience, including more than 13 years in senior clinical leadership roles, initially as Lead Nurse for an Acute Hospital Alcohol Service, then as an Advanced Clinical Practitioner (ACP) in an ACP led Rapid Diagnostics Clinic for suspected cancer, and more recently as Service Lead in a busy Urgent Treatment Centre.

Hazel holds a Master's degree in Advanced Clinical Practice with Distinction and is a qualified Non-Medical Prescriber with a broad prescribing scope, including controlled drugs and IV treatments. As an ACP, she is fully trained to assess, diagnose, treat, and discharge patients with undifferentiated and complex health needs, mirroring the clinical capacity of a medical doctor.

As Lead Nurse for the Acute Hospital Alcohol Service at the UK's largest NHS Trust, she drove innovation in alcohol-related healthcare, authoring guidelines now adopted nationally and shaping national end-of-life care pathways for patients with alcohol-related liver disease.

Urgent Treatment Centre at Stepping Hill Hospital, where in conjunction with her leadership role, she assessed patients aged 1+ presenting to the Emergency Department who were navigated to the Urgent Treatment Centre when acutely but not requiring emergency treatment. She also played an integral part in the development of an ACP led rapid-access and diagnostics service for patients with suspected cancer.

Hazel currently works in the primary care setting as an ACP in a busy city centre GP surgery, where she sees both adults and paediatric patients (aged 1+) presenting acutely/for same-day care.

Alongside her clinical work, she undertakes expert witness work, both Claimant and Defendant, and has attended Court on two occasions for the purposes of providing evidence at inquest. Building on this established experience, she is now taking on a growing portfolio of medicolegal work. She is currently pursuing CQC registration to provide specialist alcohol services both within the NHS and privately.
