Dr Mariappan is a highly accomplished Consultant in Rehabilitation Medicine with over a decade of progressive clinical, academic, and leadership experience, specialising in the management of complex neurological, amputee, and musculoskeletal rehabilitation. Currently serving as the Clinical Director for Rehabilitation Medicine at The Royal Wolverhampton NHS Trust and as a Specialty Advisor for the Care Quality Commission (CQC), Dr Mariappan plays a pivotal role in shaping clinical standards and service delivery across the UK.

He holds a Certificate of Completion of Training (CCT) in Rehabilitation Medicine (2017), and advanced international certification through ICAPMR (American Academy, 2018). Complementing his clinical expertise, he earned an MBA in Health Care & Management (UK, 2022) with a thesis focused on reducing health inequalities through smoking cessation interventions.
