RELEVANT EXPERIENCE

- □ I received training with a large Construction Consultancy and advanced to a senior role within the Surveying Department. Subsequently, I operated my own consultancy for over six years before joining Easton Bevins. Until 2025, I served as Managing Director at Easton Bevins, overseeing approximately 45 staff across offices in London, Bristol, Birmingham, and Manchester. In 2013, I established The Neighbourly Matters Consultancy, a specialist practice providing advice on neighbour and boundary disputes and Party Wall matters. Additionally, I was a director at CPM Fire Safety, a specialist firm focused on inspecting, reporting, specifying, and managing remedial works relating to defective cladding, compartmentation, and other fire safety concerns.
- I currently serve as a Consultant Expert Witness to the practice, specializing in the investigation and reporting on complex land and boundary disputes. My work frequently involves both individual and single joint expert instructions, preparation of expert reports, and providing expert expert evidence in Court proceedings and Tribunals. My other role is Compliance Manager, I am responsible for conducting regular audits, implementing staff training programs, and overseeing the adherence to statutory obligations and internal protocols set out in our Quality and Performance Manual and Staff Handbook.
- For over 35 years, I have conducted measured and topographical surveys for a range of clients. Many of these projects have involved boundary definition, dispute resolution, and determination applications. I have prepared reports and drawings related to land registration, transfers, rights of way, boundary definitions, and other matters concerning HM Land Registry.
- Since joining Easton Bevins in 2003, I have carried out numerous measured and topographical surveys, including research and assessment necessary for the production of Expert Reports. My expert work is focused on land and boundary disputes, which aligns with my area of specialization. I have been instructed and reported in more than 500 disputes and have provided expert evidence in Court and at HM Land Registry Tribunal, including experience with concurrent evidence, or 'hot-tubbing'.
- Throughout my career, I have performed surveys and inspections on various sites and properties, including modern domestic residences, historic Grade I and II listed buildings, development sites (both Greenfield and Brownfield), motor dealer showrooms, workshops, military installations, barns, and churches. My involvement also extends to planning and development for Local Authorities, obtaining planning consent for surplus building stock, and work on extensions, alterations, and refurbishments for schools, libraries, court buildings, and offices. I also have experience as a Party Wall Surveyor.

□ In 2025 I decided to concentrate my work on land and boundary disputes. I am one of four expert witnesses within the practice providing services across all kinds of construction and land related disputes.

2003 – 2025 Easton Bevins – Managing Director

- □ I rose to Managing Director of the practice, responsible for all staff and the general day to day running of the offices. As part of this role I was involved in monitoring workload and resources, the profitability of the departments, marketing, acquiring new and maintaining existing clients for the Practice.
- □ There are now approximately 45 staff employed by the practice. They include Building Surveyors, Architects, Quantity Surveyors, Project Managers and Block Managers. We have offices in Birmingham, Bristol, London and Manachester.
- □ I was regularly appointed as Party Wall Surveyor and Expert Witness along with providing support to staff and assisting clients in architectural, planning and development matters, CDM and other surveying related instructions. I was appointed as an expert witness in over 500 boundary disputes.
