from squints to non-accidental injuries. I perform ROP screening for our Trust.

I developed the Paediatric Ophthalmology service at the Aga Khan University Hospital, Karachi which is a JCI accredited academic medical centre. I also refined the ROP service where I regularly screened and treated a total of around 500 babies.

I co-authored the national guidelines for ROP treatment and Retinoblastoma management.

I served as the technical advisor to the World Health Organization for developing a Paediatric Ophthalmology care package which has since been published.

I am a member of the British & Irish Paediatric Ophthalmology & Strabismus Association (BIPOSA).

I run the Oculoplastics service at the Mid Yorkshire Teaching NHS Trust. I regularly manage a wide spectrum of Oculoplastics abnormalities, ranging from congenital ptosis to midface cancer treatment. I contribute towards the skin cancer MDT related to eyelids, and part of the North of England Oculoplastics Group.

I work as a Consultant Oculoplastics Surgeon at the Yorkshire Skin Centre, Leeds.

I have been invited as a speaker to present my research at various platforms, and most recently at the World Society of Plastics and Reconstructive Surgeon's Conference.

I developed the Oculoplastics and Orbital service at the Aga Khan University Hospital, Karachi which is a JCI accredited academic medical centre. I dealt with all forms of trauma, burns, road traffic accidents, and assault with related reconstruction. I also managed ocular and orbital cancers and developed an orbital tumour board that was first of its kind in Pakistan. I regularly treated ptosis, lid malformation and congenital abnormalities.

I also previously worked as consultant trainer at the Medicine Clinic, Warsaw, Poland where I trained doctors to become Aesthetic Oculoplastic Surgeons. We ran a course every quarter.

I was the General Secretary of the Pakistan Oculoplastics Association. From this platform we worked towards setting standards for Oculoplastics surgery, promoting education and arranging regular training for General and Oculoplastics Surgeons.

3. Cataract and Refractive Surgery

I have performed over 1000 LASIK procedures and regularly perform complex cataract surgery. I have many years of experience with refractive lens exchange. My research on toric IOLs has been published in a peer-reviewed journal.

I completed a training course from Future Topography Guided University Courses as well as a clinical attachment with Professor John Kanellopoulos. I have participated in advance practitioner courses on LASIK and premium IOLs (toric and multifocal).
