AUDIT EXPERIENCE

Audited quarterly clinical activity and presented the data at the Regional Audit Meetings of the North Thames Higher Surgical Training Scheme in Urology 2002-2007.
(15 presentations).

Audit Projects Completed:

- **Coding errors in Urology.** Institute of Urology. 1999. Retrospective audit which showed that over a years activity a third of Urological operative procedures were mis-coded resulting in mis-payment, and that only when the surgeon himself coded an operation was it accurate. *Published in the British Journal of Urology.*
- **Non-programmed elective Urological activity.** Whittington Hospital 2003. Prospective audit showing that a high proportion of the departments elective urological activity was uncoded and therefore not remunerated.
- **Twenty-three hour stay TURP procedures.** Chase Farm Hospital 2004. An audit of the effectiveness and feasibility of 30 ‘TURP’s performed by myself managed post-operatively on a 23 hour stay ward, showing that for clinically small prostates routine nurse-led trial without catheter the morning after surgery was feasible and gave good results.
- **Long term effectiveness of alpha-blocking agents for lower urinary tract symptoms.** North Middlesex Hospital. A ten year retrospective study of 120 patients showing that a high proportion progressed to TURP.
- **The value of pre-operative three-dimensional imaging for suspected muscle invasive bladder cancer patients.** Lister Hospital. A retrospective audit of the use and quality of pre-operative staging imaging of 179 patients over 2yrs showing that pre-operative imaging generally overstaged pathology and was sometimes requested unnecessarily. Led to investigation of effectiveness of preliminary resections (in progress).
