I have pursued multiple fellowships both at home (St George's Hospital) and abroad (Montpellier, France; Vancouver, Canada) to establish expertise in these areas while complimenting comprehensive neurosurgery training in Cambridge.

My academic pursuits leverage cutting-edge neuroimaging methods (ultra-high field 7T MRI, connectomics) to understand both disease mechanisms and novel treatment targets. 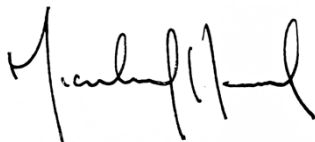
