This project was undertaken in the department of Biochemistry in the University of Jaffna in Sri Lanka. Over a period of 9 months, we sampled the alkaline phosphatase levels from patients known to be alcoholics and from age and sex matched controls. Analysis showed that the alkaline phosphatase levels were elevated in the alcoholic cohort as compared to controls. This research was presented at Jaffna University.
