Case Review



A review of medical records, clinical notes, accident reports, and correspondence allows the expert to understand the chronology of events, assess clinical history, and identify key issues. This ensures findings and recommendations are evidence-based and relevant to the litigation.

2

Assessment



An in-person or virtual evaluation tailored to the case, which may include physical, cognitive, functional, or psychological assessments. It establishes the claimant's capabilities, limitations, rehabilitation potential, and future needs, forming the basis for an evidence-based opinion on liability, causation, and quantum.

3

Report Preparation



A structured, court-compliant report providing diagnosis and prognosis supported by clinical evidence. It analyses the claimant's condition, the impact of injuries, and likely recovery or deterioration. Where relevant, it includes recommendations for treatment, rehabilitation, care, or adaptations, all presented in line with Civil Procedure Rules.

Court Attendance (if required)



If instructed, the expert may attend court to give oral evidence, explain clinical issues, and clarify their findings under cross-examination. Their role is to remain independent and objective, supporting the court in line with Part 35 of the Civil Procedure Rules.
