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About Me

I have worked in the automotive industry for over 20 years during which time I piloted a litigation department for a leading car hire company. I have worked in the care sector assisting individuals with both mental and physical needs under the Mental Health Act and Mental Capacity Act.

I joined Personal Mobility Solutions Ltd in 2018 and left in September 2026 to establish myself as an independent Personal Transport Expert Witness. I provide personal transport assessments for clients with a wide range of disabilities and needs, on both a treating and consulting basis, including Expert Witness transport reports and Part 35 instructions. Referrals are made by legal representatives, case managers or occupational therapists. My reports are detailed, impartial and evidence based, ensuring they can be relied upon in court. I have been instructed on several high-value cases, including one that resulted in a seven-figure settlement for the client.

I assess around 70–90 clients each year, typically 2–3 per week, across the UK for both passenger and driver transport needs. These assessments cover wheelchair-accessible vehicles and complex driving requirements. They are comprehensive for both claimants and defendants, addressing a wide range of disabilities, including amputation, paraplegia, tetraplegia and neurological conditions, and set out previous, current and future transport needs.

When requested, I provide consultation and advice on transport needs. I currently manage approximately 50 ongoing cases, working with solicitors, case managers and occupational therapists to source adapted vehicles and ensure they are fit for purpose and meet each client's needs.

I understand the vital importance of independence and focus on identifying practical mobility solutions for people with disabilities.

I have extensive knowledge of vehicles and conversions that meet recognised government standards and requirements. My reports include detailed analysis of individual vehicles and adaptations, including lifetime costs and replacement cycles. I regularly meet with major UK vehicle adaptation companies and attend seminars, training days and refresher courses to keep my knowledge current in this evolving industry.

I have delivered training sessions for organisations including Fletchers and Premex on the importance of personally accessible transport. I have also been invited to speak at conferences for Medico Legal, Cloisters, and Janes James & Associates.
